



A request was received from the local community to solve a water problem for the Arada area. This is a new area on the south west side of Addis Alem town. Families have been relocated there

to make way for the newly constructed flower farms but the area did not have an existing clean water supply. The picture to the right shows the water hole shared with the livestock!

With the help of a water engineer, a suitable location was identified to construct a well.



The well was hand-dug before being lined with concrete rings. A plastic pipe was then inserted and connected to a hand-pump. The well provides fresh, clean water to over a hundred households.

The well was inaugurated on the 31st December 2007 with a ceremony attended by the community, local mayor and trustees from the For Ethiopia Association.
